New Delhi Television Limited ("NDTV") Design and Architecture of the Year Awards Rules and regulations

The rules and regulations ("Rules") contained herein apply for participation in the Grohe NDTV Design and Architecture of the Year Awards. These Awards shall celebrate architectural excellence in India.

Award categories

The Award categories may be changed / modified / split / merged / increased or cancelled by the Jury based on the number and quality of entries received in each category. In the event that no Participant in a category is found to be worthy of inclusion by the Jury, the Award category may be cancelled by the Jury. The Jury may decide to add nominees in the category to maintain high standards of participation. The decision of the Jury in this regard will be final and non-contestable. The Awards management will not entertain any queries in this regard

Eligibility criteria

- Participants applying for the Awards should be architects and interior designers residing within the geographical territory of India. (Firms & Sole Proprietorships based in India only)
- Only the projects which have been completed between 1st January, 2013 and 30th
 November, 2015 are eligible for participation. Not yet started/ future projects/ partially completed/ incomplete projects are not eligible for participation.
- Employees and immediate family members of NDTV, sponsors and partners of the awards are not allowed to participate in the Awards

• The final eligibility of the Participant will be subject to the discretion and approval of Jury.

Instructions for submitting the application form (via web portal only)

- Nomination forms to be completed on the web portal <u>www.ndtv.com/daawards/</u>
- Participants can nominate multiple projects within a particular Award Category, and a particular project within multiple Award Categories. Participants need to register separate nominations for each project nominated in each Award Category.
- Each nomination must be supplemented by two A2 sized boards (landscape or portrait format). Rules to prepare A2 boards are as under:
 - The boards must include project name, location, plans, min of 8 photographs of the completed project and a brief written description (100 - 150 words) of the project and design process in English. There is no limit on the max number of images that can be used as long as the entire presentation does not exceed the two boards.
 - Maximum board size is 420 x 594mm (approximately 16.5 inches x 23.4 inches)
 - When you register a project in an Award Category, a six digit unique numerical code will be generated by NDTV. The code needs to be written on the bottom right of the A2 board being submitted.
 - To ensure anonymity in judging, names of entrants or collaborating parties must not appear on any part of the board.
 - Boards with the architect's name or firm name will be disqualified

Images :

Please ensure each nomination contains a minimum of 8 images of the project. The images must convey & highlight the best aspects of the project entered.

- 1. Architecture Category : Entry must include both Interior & exterior pictures for the project.
- 2. Interior Category : Images used should clearly depict the interior space of the building/project
- 3. Heritage Category : Restoration & Preservation Projects must include **before and after pictures**

Eligibility Criteria for the "Environmental Awards" categories

Any project can we entered under the Environmental design category. The awards will be judged based on how the design had responded to the local climatic conditions and incorporated passive features to reduce consumption requirements.

For your information some examples of passive features are

- Optimized Form/Orientation
- Thermal Mass / Insulation
- Solar Shading
- Maximize Day lighting and yet reducing Glare
- Natural Ventilation
- Microclimate Modification / Evaporative Cooling
- Vegetation (Trees for shade, Green Roofs etc.)
- Local Materials

Timelines and receipt of entries

- Efforts will be made to adhere to the defined timelines. However, the defined timelines are subject to change based on circumstances. Awards Management and its sub-contractors shall not be held accountable / liable for any disruptions / stoppages / interruptions or cancellation of the Awards or its ceremony or any part of its processes or public voting on account of any factors beyond its control.
- Last date for receiving completed application forms, along with supporting documents is 18:00 hrs. Indian Standard Time on 30th November, 2015.
- Awards Ceremony to be conducted on 15th January, 2016.
- Receipt of application forms after last date of receipt specified may be permitted only at the discretion of the Awards Management.
- Awards Management will not be responsible for application forms that are damaged / lost due to lack or lapse in any communication on account of internet failure.

Short-listing procedure and determination of winners

- All the nominations received shall be collated and presented to the Jury for initial evaluation, based on pre-defined evaluation criteria, to determine the nominees & winners in each Award category. Awards Management reserves the right to reclassify nomination from one category to another category without requiring prior approval from the participant.
- If a nomination is shortlisted, then one representative of the shortlisted

company must be available to attend the Awards Ceremony).

- Jury scores or ranking will be tabulated by the Auditors to determine one (or more) Final Winner(s) in each award category.
- The winner will be declared at the Awards Ceremony to be held in Bangalore and be presented with the Award.
- Participants may be contacted for any additional information to verify the information provided. Such information sourced from the Participants will become part of the original application

<u>General</u>
